World Thinking Day

World Thinking Day Celebration was held on 21st February 2025 at the Seliamedu Centre with great enthusiasm. Organized and conducted by Kandavel Sir, the event saw the active participation of 48 students and seven teachers. Vinoth addressed the gathering, introducing this year's theme, "Her Story," while Kandavel Sir explained the origins, purpose, and the organization behind the inception of World Thinking Day. Students took part in five interactive games designed to stimulate both hemispheres of the brain and enhance critical thinking skills. Teachers also joined in activities aimed at improving cognitive functions. The lively participation and enthusiasm of all involved made the celebration a memorable one.

On 18th March 2025, the Seliamedu Satya Special School successfully hosted a Science Fair Program, organized by Mrs. Ashvini, Mr. Vinoth, and the Seliamedu school staff.
